



SECOND CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEAL

ORDER

Acting in accordance with the Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1, the inherent power of the Court, and considering the Proclamation Number JBE 2020-30 and the emergency conditions created due to the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic:

IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to the Proclamation (Number JBE 2020-30) by the Governor of the State of Louisiana, John Bel Edwards, that for purposes of computing the timeliness of filings, the period of the suspension of legal deadlines (ending April 13, 2020) shall be considered a legal holiday; and thus, pleadings otherwise due in this Court during this legal holiday shall be due within seven (7) days of the resumption of normal court operation (April 20, 2020). The Court will continue to process all filings made prior to April 20, 2020;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the entire docket set for April is re-set for Monday, May 18, 2020. The Clerk's Office shall give the necessary notices to all attorneys and self-represented parties affected by the re-setting. This order supersedes this Court's order of March 15, 2020, continuing all cases set for oral argument without date.
