We will help you if we can, and we will treat everyone equally. However, we are allowed by law to help you only in certain ways.

We Can	We Cannot
Answer general questions about how the court works	Explain judicial decisions or let you speak to judges outside of the courtroom
Provide you with contact information for legal services programs	Refer you to specific lawyers, contact programs or lawyers for you, or give answers that involve legal advice
Give you general information about court rules, terminology, procedures, and practices	Advise you as to how specific court rules and procedures may be applied to your case
Provide the court calendar and information on the procedures for making a filing or taking a writ or an appeal	Advise you whether you should make a filing or take a writ or an appeal, or give you an opinion about what will happen if you do so
Provide you with certain information about your case	Provide you with information that has been restricted by court order or law
Provide to you or refer you to court rules and the court's <i>Pro Se</i> Manual	Tell you how you should prepare your filings or complete for you any forms required by this court
Review your filings by checking for compliance with court rules, signatures, notarization, and trial court information	Prepare or correct filings for you
Make available the record of your case for your use in preparation of your filings	Assist in or research the record for you or answer specific questions about the content
Answer general questions about court deadlines	Calculate court deadlines for you
Tell you what to expect if your case is argued in this court	Tell you what to say in court
Tell you whether or not an order has been issued and what the order is	Interpret the court's orders, talk to the Judges for you, or change an order from the Judges
