Applicants, DT Midstream, Inc. and DTM Louisiana Gathering, L.L.C., seek supervisory review of the trial court's April 17, 2023, Ruling granting a preliminary injunction, ordering the plaintiff to post a bond, and denying Applicants' reconventional demand. Applicants also seek supervisory review of the trial court's April 20, 2023, Order modifying the prior Ruling and denying Applicants' request for a temporary restraining order instead of their entire reconventional demand. The judgments for which Applicants seek supervisory review are appealable judgments for which Applicants have also sought a devolutive appeal pursuant to La. C.C.P. art. 3612. Under the circumstances of this case, we conclude that exercise of this Court's supervisory review is not warranted. Accordingly, the writ is denied. The Applicants' claims will be considered under the Court's appellate jurisdiction in due course after the Applicants' requested appeal has lodged in this Court.
