ORDER

Applicant, Taylor Jackson Kerley, complains that the trial court has not complied with this Court's June 7, 2023, order of mandamus directing the trial court to enter a dispositive ruling on Kerley's pro se "Motion for Speedy Trial." Although the trial court set this matter for contradictory hearing on July 24, 2023, the case minutes show that the trial court has still failed to dispose of Kerley's July 8, 2021, motion. Accordingly, the applicant's motion to enforce is hereby granted and the case is remanded to the trial court with instructions to enter a dispositive ruling on Kerley's motion for speedy trial within 30 days of this order. If the trial court has previously complied with the order, it is directed to provide a copy of the

order or ruling to the applicant and his attorney, the district attorney and this Court, within 10 days of this order.
