ORDER

Applicants and Defendants, Ouachita Parish Sheriff Jay Russell and Ouachita Sheriff's Deputy Donovan Ginn sought a writ of mandamus directed to the trial court to rule on their notice of intent to seek supervisory review, filed on October 16, 2023.
