ORDER

The appellants, Trey Brooks, Tristan Brooks and Alandre' Brooks individually and on behalf of Donovan Brooks, have filed a motion to supplement the appellate record with the written reasons for judgment from the case of *Da'Vyta Gray v. Town of Ringgold, Bienville Parish Sheriff's Office, The Bienville Parish Police Jury, et al*, docket 46,729 for the Second Judicial District Court, currently on appeal at this Court bearing docket No. 56,515-CA. Appellants also seek a 7-day extension of their briefing delays. By order of this Court on May 22, 2025, these appeals have been consolidated for docketing purposes. However, the record before this Court in the present appeal does not show that the written reasons for judgment in No. 56,515-CA, *Da'Vyta Gray v. Town of Ringgold, Bienville Parish Sheriff's Office, The Bienville Parish Police Jury, et al*, *Gray v. Town of Ringgold, et al*, were formally introduced into the record at the trial court. Documentation of other courts' proceedings must be offered into evidence in the usual manner. *Triche v. Triche*, 24-369 (La. App. 5 Cir. 2/26/25), 2025 WL 621429; *Parent v. Louisiana Dep't of Pub. Safety & Corr.*, 21-0897 (La. App. 1 Cir. 3/3/22), 341 So. 3d 804. The appellants may seek supplementation in the Second Judicial District Court, as it is in a better position to make the determination of whether or not the reasons for judgment should be made a part of this appellate record. La. C.C.P. arts. 2132 and 2088. Accordingly, the motion to supplement the record and request for an extension of briefing delays are denied.
