## ORDER

The defendant, Michael W. Harris, appealed his conviction and sentence for molestation of a person with a physical or mental disability. Appellate defense counsel has filed a motion to dismiss this appeal on the basis that the defendant died on March 7, 2025. The motion is granted and this appeal is dismissed. In accordance with *State v. Gleason*, 21-01788 (La. 11/10/22), 349 So. 3d 977, the matter is remanded to the trial court with instructions to enter a notation in the record that while the conviction removed the defendant's presumption of innocence, it was neither affirmed nor reversed on appeal due to his death.
