WRIT GRANTED AND MADE PEREMPTORY; REMANDED.

The applicant, Monterius Daitrell Simpson, seeks supervisory review of the trial court's denial of his motion to quash. We find that the trial court abused its discretion. The one-year time limit to commence trial expired and the State failed to establish an interruption or suspension of the time limit. See La. C. Cr. P. arts. 578-80. Accordingly, this writ is granted and the trial court's ruling denying the applicant's motion to quash is reversed. This matter is remanded to the trial court for further proceedings.
