WRIT GRANTED; REVERSED; REMANDED WITH INSTRUCTIONS.

The Applicants, Willis-Knighton Health System D/B/A Willis-Knighton Bossier Health Center and Dr. Kelly Wright Lambard, M.D., seek review of a ruling of the trial court, ordering the release of the unaltered and unredacted

credentialing file of Dr. Kelly Wright Lambard to Plaintiffs. It appearing to this Court that some documents within the credentialing file of Dr. Lambard are privileged and not subject to discovery, the writ is granted and that portion of the Judgment of November 25, 2025, which ordered the production of the entire, unaltered and unredacted credentialing file of Dr. Kelly Lambard to Plaintiffs, is reversed. This matter is remanded to the trial court with instructions to reconsider its *in camera* review of the credentialing file of Dr. Kelly Lambard, to determine which documents are privileged per La. R.S. 13:3715.3 as internal documents produced and maintained by Willis-Knighton Health System in connection with its peer review processes, and which documents contain merely factual accountings of otherwise discoverable facts, or are otherwise subject to discovery. App. 3 Cir. 9/24/25), 422 So. 3d 353; *In re Porche*, 24-0792 (La. App. 4 Cir. 6/2/25), 414 So. 3d 1210; *Frederick v. St. Charles Surgical Hosp., LLC*, 24-526 (La. App. 5 Cir. 12/23/24), 410 So. 3d 905, writ denied, 25-00189 (La. 4/29/25), 407 So. 3d 623; *Danos v. Minnard*, 19-268 (La. App. 5 Cir. 8/28/19), 279 So. 3d 486.
