WRIT OF MANDAMUS DENIED.

The applicant, Carlos Martel Lynn Smith, seeks a writ of mandamus directing the district court to set a return date on his “Notice of Intent to Seek Supervisory Writ of Review.” This Court does not require U.R.C.A. 4-2 and 4-3 compliance in *pro se* applications for post-conviction relief, and it is unnecessary for Smith to be granted a return date by the district court prior to the filing of his application for supervisory review with this Court. Accordingly, this writ is denied. The applicant may file his application seeking review of the post-conviction ruling in this Court without any further orders from the district court.
