WRIT GRANTED; REMANDED FOR PERFECTION AS AN APPEAL.

The trial court's December 9, 2025, signed, written "Judgment" denying applicant's exceptions and oral motion to continue and granting a judgment of eviction has been supplemented into the writ record. The judgment of eviction is a final, appealable judgment. Applicant's oral notice of intent to seek writs was timely as a motion for appeal, and under *Shows v. Shows*, 434 So. 2d 1090 (La. 1983), the trial court's order fixing the time for filing is hereby treated as an order of appeal. A suspensive or devolutive appeal may be taken from a judgment in a summary eviction hearing. *Polk v. Buckhalter*, 18-0053 (La. App. 1. Cir. 9/24/18), 258 So. 3d 816; *Terrebonne Par. Port Comm'n v. Eagle Dry Dock & Marine Repairs, L.L.C.*, 14-0010 (La. App. 1 Cir. 7/7/15), 2015 WL 4094331. This matter is hereby remanded to the trial court for perfection of the appeal.
