**WRIT DENIED.**

The applicant, Okyeame Woodard, seeks review of the trial court's ruling of February 4, 2026, denying his "Motion to Quash the Grand Jury Indictment, Motion to Set Aside the Invalid Verdict and Motion to Correct an Invalid Illegal Sentence." Woodard's filings are properly viewed as an application for post-conviction relief. As Woodard's conviction and sentence became final in 2013, his current application for post-conviction relief filed November 7, 2025, is untimely under La. C. Cr. P. art. 930.8, and he fails to prove that any exception to the time limit applies to his claims. La. C. Cr. P. art. 930.2. Accordingly, this writ is denied.
