WRIT DENIED IN PART; WRIT GRANTED IN PART AND REMANDED.

The applicant, Ronald Leleaux, III, seeks supervisory review of the trial court's November 13, 2025, ruling denying his request for records. On the showing made, the writ is granted in part to reverse that portion of the trial court's ruling which denied Leleaux documents to which he is entitled by right. This matter is remanded to the trial court, which is ordered to provide Leleaux with free copies of his bill of information, the case minutes, and the documents committing him into custody. *State ex rel. Bernard v. Criminal District Court Section "J,"* 94-2247 (La. 4/28/95), 653 So. 2d 1174; *State ex rel. Simmons v. State*, 93-0175 (La. 12/16/94), 647 So. 2d 1094. As to all other requests, the writ is denied on the showing made. La. C. Cr. P. art. 930.2; *State ex rel. Brown v. State*, 03-2568 (La. 3/26/04), 870 So. 2d 976 and *State ex rel. Fleury v. State*, 93-2898 (La. 10/13/95), 661 So. 2d 488.
