REHEARING GRANTED; WRIT DENIED.

The applicants, Gastroenterology and Nutritional Medicine Services, APMC and Raj Bhandari, M.D., seek rehearing of their writ application on the showing that the writ was “not considered” due to untimely filing. Applicants have shown that the writ application was timely filed on April 27, 2026, and the rehearing of this matter is granted.

Applicants now seek supervisory review of the trial court’s denial of an exception of prescription, which would dismiss both the survival action and the wrongful death action alleged by plaintiffs, as well as review of the trial court’s

denial of their motion in limine regarding Dr. Stephen Cohen and Dr. Marie Houghton. This application does not substantially comply with URCA 4-5, as it lacks a transcript of the hearing or a copy of the opposition to the motion in limine. On the showing made, we decline to exercise this Court’s supervisory jurisdiction. Accordingly, this writ is hereby denied.
