WRIT DENIED.

Applicant Larry Clark seeks review of the July 7, 2026, ruling of the trial court denying his motion to recuse the trial court in this matter. While such a judgment is interlocutory and non-appealable, we note that Clark has been granted an appeal of the August 4, 2026, Judgment of the trial court dismissing Clark's amended petitions for nullity with prejudice, awarding sanctions and rescinding Clark's pauper status. Because the denial of the motion to recuse at issue in the writ application can be assigned as error in the unrestricted appeal, Clark has an

adequate remedy on appeal. *Carrollton Presbyterian Church v. Presbytery of South Louisiana of Presbyterian Church (USA)*, 11-0205 (La. App. 1 Cir. 9/14/11), 77 So. 3d 975, writ denied, 11-2590 (La. 2/17/12), 82 So. 3d 285, cert. denied, 568 U.S. 818, 133 S. Ct. 150, 184 L. Ed. 2d 32 (2012). Accordingly, the writ is denied.
